Exceptions to the general criteria:

1. The setting of higher evaluation standards for a specific Ph.D. program is at the discretion of the program committee. Such alternative standards need to have the approval of the respective faculty, and the Graduate School needs to be notified.

2. Programs with English proficiency requirements set prior to this announcement should inform the Graduate School of their criteria.

3. International Ph.D. applicant must follow a program's admission criteria for international students, and programs need to inform the Graduate School about such applications.

4. If a Ph.D. applicant does not submit an English Language proficiency certificate as listed above, the applicant must undergo a test with Tell Me More program with the appropriate test topic, level and skills determined by the faculty or program committee.
